
LOCATION & DIRECTIONS

The Heart Walk celebration site is the Back Cove Trail Parking Lot on Preble Street, Portland, ME. The parking lot is located across from Hannaford at 295 Forest Ave, Portland, ME.

PARKING

Parking is available in the four highlighted locations on the map.

- 1. The parking garage at Intermed Building at 84 Marginal Way
- 2. The Portland Post Office Parking Lot at 26 Marginal Way
- 3. The Gorham Savings Bank Parking Lot at 63 Marginal way
- 4. The AAA Northern New England Parking lot at 68 Marginal Way

REGISTRATION

- If you **HAVE** registered as a participant on the Heart Walk website you DO NOT need to check-in or register at the Heart Walk.
- If you HAVE NOT registered as a participant on the Heart Walk website you MUST stop at the Registration/Donation Collection tent in the Back Cove Trail parking lot to sign a Participant Waiver.
- HINT HINT Visit <u>MaineHeartWalk.org</u> and register for the Heart Walk prior to May 15 and you will be able to bypass registration and enjoy the celebration!



DONATIONS

Participants may turn in donations at the Heart Walk. While we request that you make donations online through the website or app, if you are paying with cash or checks, place in a sealed envelope marked with the donor's name, along with the team or participant's name to whom the contributions are to be attributed.

MORE INFORMATION.

HEART WALK

- The 3.5-mile Heart Walk take place around the Back Cove Pathway.
- The walkers will being walking from the Back Cove Trail Parking Lot celebration site at 9:00 am—10:30 am.
- MIRACLE MILE: There is an optional 1-miles walk route.
 Continue 1/2-mile down the route until you see the sign
 asking Miracle Mile walkers to turn around and walk back to
 the Start Line.



FIRST AID & EMERGENCY

- An ambulance from North East Mobile Health Services will be available at the celebration site from 8:00 am - 12:00 pm
- We will have a golf cart circling the route to assist any walkers who need help.
- In the event of an emergency, please call 911 and find the nearest volunteer to assist you.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS.

SURVIVOR RED & WHITE CAPS & RED CAPES

The Heart Walk celebrates and honors individuals who have survived cardiovascular disease and/or stroke. We present heart survivors with a red cap, stroke survivors with a white cap, and pediatric survivors with a red cape.

FOOD & DRINKS

- Water, granola bars, and bananas will be available to all participants prior to the walk.
- There will be two hydration stations along the water route.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS.

WHAT TO WEAR & WHAT TO BRING

- The weather in May is constantly changing, so it's best to layer your clothing and be prepared for varying temperatures.
- Wear sneakers or comfortable shoes.
- Strollers and wagons are welcome. Note that light umbrella type strollers can be difficult to push on the Back Cove Pathway.

- Masks will be available at registration.
- Hand sanitizer will be available in all port-o-potties and on tables through the event.
