

Parking Options around Bushnell Park:

- Top Walkers, ELT & Board Members, and Invited Guests will be provided a pass for a reserved space in the Connecticut State Capitol Lot.
- The closest parking to the Bushnell Performance Pavilion and the Walk Starting Arch is the **ProPark Mobility** lot across from Union Station (behind the Red Roof Inn on Union Place). A special \$4 Heart Walk rate is available until 1 PM.
- The **ProPark Mobility** lot at the corner of High & Church Streets will also be offering a \$4 Heart Walk rate until 1 PM.
- The Legislative Office Building Garage at 300 Capitol Avenue will be open to Heart Walkers. No cost.
- On street parking along Elm & Trinity Streets is available. Be mindful of the planned road closure on Trinity Street during the Heart Walk itself.
- Additional paid parking is available at lots on Asylum Avenue.

Walk Route:

The 2019 Heart Walk is a non-competitive 3-mile walk. The route is a 1-mile loop.





<u>Hartford HealthCare Employee Shuttle</u>

Members and guests of Hartford HealthCare Heart Walk Teams may elect to park in their employee garages at the Hartford Hospital Campus and utilize the LAZ Shuttle service to Bushnell Park.

Shuttles will run between 8 AM & 1 PM. Board the shuttle at the parking circle at the ERC Main Entrance on Hudson Street. Drop off will at the Park will be at the corners of Elm & Trinity Streets, where riders will also board for the return ride back to the Hartford Hospital Campus.

(UPDATE: Your leashed pet will be allowed on the shuttle bus!)

Frequently Asked Questions

What about inclement weather?

Because Heart Walks cannot be rescheduled it is a rain or shine event. Please dress accordingly.



Can I bring my dog on the Walk?

Yes! Fur-friends welcomed! Well behaved dogs on leashes can certainly participate. Water bowls will be out at the MDC Hydration Station.

Are strollers allowed?

Absolutely. The Heart Walk is a family-friendly event. The Walk itself is on paved surfaces and sidewalks.

Can I bring friends if they haven't registered?

Please do! Anyone is welcome to attend the Heart Walk. However, we do encourage them to register online in advance to help us determine how many participants to expect. Registration online is done at: www.HartfordHeartWalk.org

Event-day registrants must complete the simple waiver form at the Registration Tent.

What if I or one of my team members can't walk 3 miles?

That's fine. We understand. The route this year is designed as three 1-mile loops. Do what you can!

I'm already registered online. Do I need to register at the event?

Nope. But do drop off any donations you may have between 9-10 AM, please.
