RESEARCH

We are fast-tracking a special \$2.5 million fund for rapid response scientific research projects to investigate the specific cardiovascular implications of coronavirus, with a goal of developing more effective treatments quickly - potentially within the next 6-8 months.



SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

The Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory is using the technologies created by the AHA Center for Accelerated Drug Discovery to help accelerate antiviral drugs to combat COVID-19. We have an immediate opportunity to leverage these learnings and propel new discoveries to better diagnose and, ultimately, treat COVID-19.



HEALTH CARE

Our health care workers are on the front lines of this pandemic, and we are working with them to ensure they have the training and resources they need in response to the shortage of trained ICU personnel for using ventilators.

As physicians, scientists and researchers worldwide struggle to understand the COVID-19 pandemic, we are developing a free registry - the very first of its kind - to gather and share data and aid research on the disease, treatment protocols and risk factors associated with cardiovascular health.

We are teaching hospitals and communities how to safely and effectively administer CPR during the coronavirus pandemic.

We are helping parents, students and workplaces understand how to minimize risk when out and about, stay active, eat healthy and be well when at home, and how people with cardiovascular conditions may be at increased risk.
