



Heart Walk. Frequently Asked Questions

Should I register ahead of time? Absolutely! Registering online at <u>www.heart.org/ClevelandWalk</u> gives you access to all our great fundraising tools and keeps you updated on day of event info.

Can I participate in Heart Walk if I'm not on a team? Sure, you can walk and fundraise individually. Every donation will help create big science! But hey, since you're already on board, maybe consider starting a team and asking friends, family and coworkers to join you as a Heart Walk hero.

Is there an indoor option in case of rain? No, the Heart Walk will take place, rain or shine, outdoors.

Are kids and strollers allowed? Definitely! We do ask that you supervise your children when they are in the Kids Zone. Strollers are also permitted!

Will you have water? We promise to keep you hydrated! Bring your reuseable water bottle, as we will have a water provided by Kinetico Water Systems. We will also have bottled water available, generously donated by Giant Eagle.

Are pets allowed? Yes, but please know this is a family-friendly event. Non-aggressive, leashed pets are welcome at the event. Please clean up after your dog and make sure you stop by the Pet Zone!

Can I turn in money at the Heart Walk? You sure can! Stop by the American Heart Association tent outside of The Lakehouse. Otherwise, no check in needed, just lace up & show up to walk!

How are donations made? Donations can be made securely to your fundraising page with a credit card, PayPal, Venmo and more. Cash and checks (made payable to the American Heart Association) may also be collected. You can deposit checks directly through the <u>Heart Walk App</u>!

Will I receive a Heart Walk t-shirt? All walkers who raise \$100+ can redeem Heart Walk Hero Gear from our <u>Heart Walk Rewards Center</u> in your <u>Heart Walk Headquarters</u> and in the <u>Heart Walk App</u>. There are so many cool options to choose, and the best part is they will be shipped directly to you after you redeem them. **The Rewards Center is available through November 8, 2024.**

JO ANN HABLITZEL MEMORIAL RESEARCH


Jo Ann (Konieczny) Hablitzel was the youngest of seven children born to Polish immigrants in Oak Harbor, Ohio. She was very involved in school events, was an excellent student and went on to graduate from Bowling Green State University with a degree in Education. She married Charles Hablitzel, whom she met in high school, and they raised their four children in Oak Harbor.

Jo Ann taught middle school math in the Oak Harbor school system (Benton Carroll Salem) for nearly 30 years and she invested in her students both in and out of the classroom. She was a leader in her small-town community, teaching Sunday school and supporting local charities, as well enjoying nights with the girls in her card club! Jo Ann had a sense of humor, engaging personality and was always willing to help a neighbor. She also had a collection of angels throughout her home and believed they existed in Heaven and on Earth.



Jo Ann passed away suddenly at the age of 61 on July 28, 2002, due to complications following a mild heart attack. It was discovered that she was allergic to the blood thinner medication she received.

In her memory, Jo Ann's son Tom and his wife Jan established the Jo Ann Hablitzel Legacy Research Reception in Cleveland. This Research Reception is an opportunity for invitees to enjoy a behind-thescenes look at how funds donated in support of the American Heart Association are helping to advance medical research and education right here in Northeast Ohio. Tom and Jan also established the Hablitzel Family Pre-Doctoral Fellowship in cardiovascular research, to help spark the career of an aspiring local researcher, lead to future innovations in the fight against heart diseases & stroke and hopefully prevent other families from losing their loved ones too early.
