

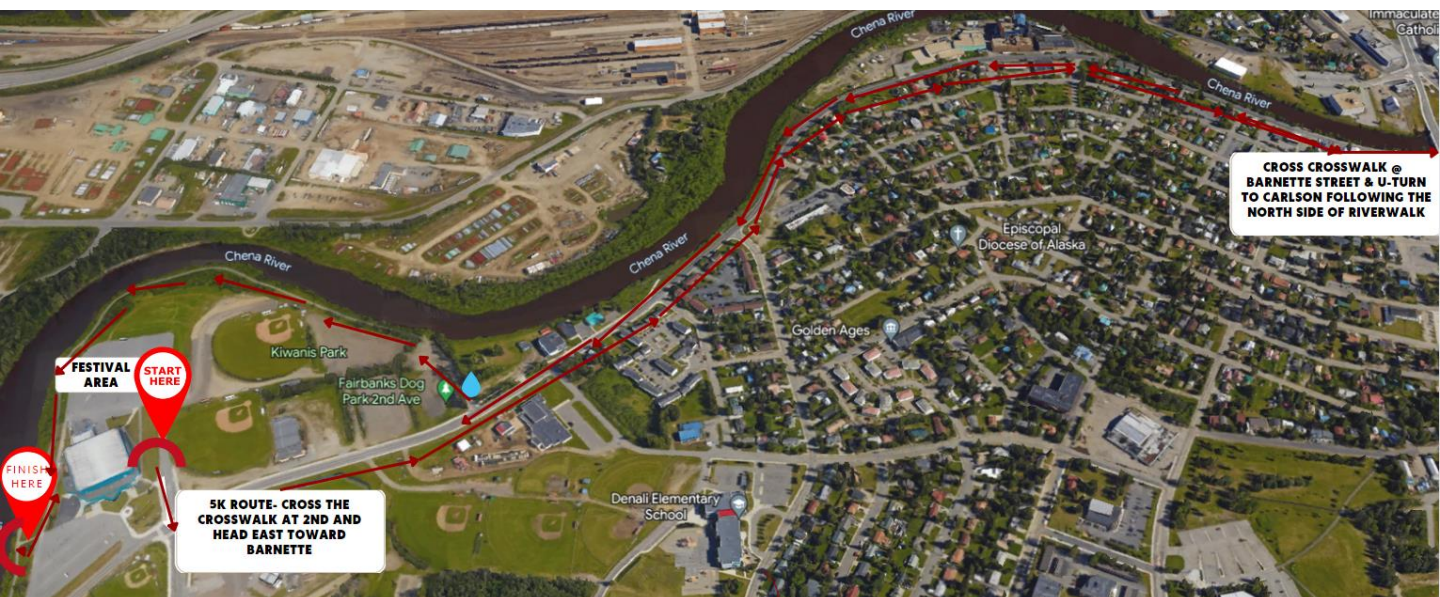

**Carlson Center, Chena Riverwalk–
5K Route Map**



5K Route Directions

- The Route begins at the Carlson Center, 2010 2nd Avenue, Fairbanks, AK 99701.
- Exit the back parking lot and cross the crosswalk at 2nd and Moore to be on the south side of the street and head east toward Barnette.
- Continue to Barnette. Following traffic safety laws, cross the crosswalk at Barnette to get to the north side of the street and head back toward the Carlson Center.
- When you arrive at the dog park, turn right to stay on the Chena Riverwalk.
- Follow the path to the finish arch (located on the side of the Carlson Center)
- Pass the finish line, survivors- take part in the survivor moment sponsored by Alaska Heart & Vascular Institute and turn left to take the dirt path back to the festival area.
- The Route concludes at the Carlson Center, rear parking lot 2010 2nd Avenue, Fairbanks, AK 99701

Survivor Route Map**



1-Mile Survivor Route Directions

- The Route begins at the Carlson Center, 2010 2nd Avenue, Fairbanks, AK 99701.
- Stay on the south side of the road. Do NOT cross the street at the crosswalk on 2nd with the 5k participants.
- Follow the Riverwalk as it curves along the riverbank.
- As you pass the dog park on your left, turn left to return to Carlson Center, following the Chena Riverwalk
- Follow the path to the finish arch (located on the side of Carlson Center)
- Pass the finish line, survivors- take part in the survivor moment sponsored by Alaska Heart & Vascular Institute and turn left to take the dirt path back to the festival area.
- The Route concludes at the Carlson Center, rear parking lot 2010 2nd Avenue, Fairbanks, AK 99701

2024 Fairbanks Heart Walk Directions

This is a route map for the 2024 Fairbanks Heart Walk, taking place in downtown Fairbanks, Alaska. The walk starts at the Carlson Center and ends back at the Carlson Center, following the Chena Riverwalk. There are two routes to choose from- a 5K or 1 mi option. Both Start and Finish are in the same location. To stay on the 1 Mi route, turn left onto 2nd Ave to stay on the north side of the road. Do not cross at the crosswalk. Continue East and turn left at the Dog Park to follow the Chena Riverwalk back to the Carlson Center. To opt for the 5K course, head east toward 2nd and cross the street at 2nd Ave & Moore, to be on the south side of the road and head toward Barnett. Continue up the sidewalk until you reach Barnett. Once to Barnett, use the crosswalk to cross to the north side of the street and follow the Chena Riverwalk back toward Carlson Center. When you arrive at the dog park, turn right to stay on the Chena Riverwalk. The finish arch will be at the side/front lot of the Carlson Center. Cross the finish arch. Survivors- be sure to participate in the survivor moment, sponsored by Alaska Heart & Vascular Institute. All participants will continue on the dirt/gravel path back to the rear lot of the Carlson Center. This takes participants back to the festival area. Awards Ceremony at the stage at 1:00PM.

- Please follow all traffic safety laws and be aware of uneven sidewalks and merging traffic.
- There is a water truck to refill your water bottle in the festival area.

Parking:

The rear parking lot is extremely convenient, located only about 200 feet from the main entrance of the Carlson Center. The proximity provides a very short walk to arrive at the festival area and starting point for the route. Street parking in surrounding areas is also available. Drivers should look for signs for the Carlson Center parking lot in the rear lot. Please note- there is a health fair in the front lot of the Carlson Center ending at **12PM**. Please be aware of traffic and pedestrians in the front lot. **The Carlson Center front lot will be off limits to participants and vendors until after 1PM.**
