

Village Map and New Routes!




2024 PITTSBURGH HEART WALK New Routes!

Parking Information


A discounted parking rate of \$5 will be available in the Gateway
Center Garage on Liberty Avenue 400 Liberty Ave, Pittsburgh PA 15222.
Other garages in the area, including the PPG garage, should be open, at standard rates. Additionally, the Pittsburgh T line is an option! The Wood Street T station is near the Smithfield Liberty Parking garage \$5 on the weekend, take to the Gateway Station and walk to Point State Park!

How to use QR Code: Scan the QR Code at the entry ticket machine scanner, and the exit ticket will dispense from the entry ticket machine. (Please note: You must have this ticket to exit the garage)



The exit ticket cost is \$5 and can be paid by credit card when leaving for the day. When leaving, pay for the ticket at the pay-on-foot machines or in the exit lane (credit card only) at the exit machine when leaving the garage.

Walking Directions from Parking lot to Point State Park: -Head West on Liberty Ave toward Commonwealth PL (262 ft) -Turn Right onto Commonwealth PL (358 ft) -ARRIVE
