Beach Ride

Beach Ride Rules and Event Reminders

- All Riders must be Register with the American Heart Association. You will receive your Official Beach Ride Wristband at Check In and will be required to wear it . NO BAND! NO RIDING!
- NO STALLIONS ALLOWED.
- All horses must have a Negative Coggins Test completed within a year of the event.
- It is State Law, when traveling into South Carolina from another state, you must provide a Current Health Certificate for your Horse.
- Superstar Details-
 - Entry Superstar Entry to the Campground will take place on Tuesday.
 - ONLY Superstars and their IMMEDIATE FAMILY are welcome to join us on Tuesday.
 - Immediate Family includes your Significant Other, Children, Parents, Siblings, and/or Camping Partner.
 - Horses should be in the SAME Trailer and Riders should be in the same truck. (Unless on vehicle is pulling a camper).

Rules and Reminders During the Event

- Please STAY OFF the sand dunes at all times. This is mandated by law.
- NO RIDING ON THE BEACH AT NIGHT!
- For the safety of all participants and horses, riding must remain at a controlled pace. Galloping, racing, or aggressive riding ('cowboying') is not permitted on the beach or campground.
- If you are riding in a group and encounter folks walking on the beach, make sure your entire group passes on the same side of the walkers giving them plenty of room.
- Lakewood prohibits alcohol.
- Please do not ride South of Lakewood! And only ride past the Springmaid Pier on Saturday.
- Horseback riding will be permitted in designated areas of the campground and on the beach Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, Saturday, and Sunday. On Saturday, the organized ride day, please listen to our patrol riders. You are responsible for cleaning up after your horse and other animals in the campground. Your campsite must be left the same as when you arrived.
- ONLY OFFICIAL VENDORS OF THE BEACH RIDE ARE ALLOWED TO SELL ITEMS AT THE EVENT. For more information or to become a vendor call the American Heart Association Staff.
- All Riders are required to clean up after their horses in all areas landward of the high tide line. PLEASE RIDE AS CLOSE TO THE TIDE LINE AS POSSIBLE.
- DO NOT ENTER ANY OTHER CAMPGROUNDS OR LEAVE THE BEACH OTHER THAN TO ENTER LAKEWOOD CAMPING RESORT.
