A Note From Our Executive Director

This June, after six years' leading our regional-level community impact efforts for the American Heart Association, I moved with my family to Nashville to take on the honor of leading our efforts in Middle TN as the new Executive Director.

After her second day of school in our new home in Nashville, my 10-year old daughter Amelia brought me a "Getting to Know You" document that she had started for her new teacher. Favorite food: twice-baked potatoes; Favorite past-time: reading. Hero: My mom, because she moved us to Nashville to make it a better place to live.

So after I caught my breath and pretended I didn't have a tear on my cheek, I reflected upon this incredible compliment. It is also a call to action, and at a time when the cost of poor heart health is devastating Nashville and the nation.

In 2020 we saw overall life expectancy drop by two years, and heart disease remained a leading cause of death. In fact, deaths from heart disease and stroke increased during COVID. The risk factors for heart disease (obesity, high blood pressure, low access to health care, etc) are the same drivers of COVID death. The past two years have shined a light on the high cost of health disparities and untreated

poor heart health, and turned a spotlight on the need for stronger community cohesion and trust.

Last year in Nashville we worked with clinics to continue to provide blood pressure care to patients during COVID. Our hospitals participated in a no-cost COVID registry. We converted our STEM courses to digital formats and reached more students. We launched campaigns around going to the ER (after ER visits for cardiac arrests dropped dramatically), why to get vaccinated, the importance of mental health and well-being, and getting back to primary care.

Since we have moved here, I have been so impressed by the hospitality, generosity, and depth of community leadership. Together, we have accomplished so much. Yet every single person I have spoken to acknowledges that we also have so much more to do. Under the leadership of our Middle TN Board of Directors, we have built a strategy to achieve incredible growth and impact by 2024, the 100th anniversary of the American Heart Association and the 50th anniversary of the Heart Gala. We aim to raise millions more for our mission and reach more than one million people through our local work.

Don't tell Amelia this, but she's wrong about the hero here. It's you, the leaders in our community who drive our organization and team to extraordinary accomplishments. Together we can accomplish the goals to raise more funds for our lifesaving mission and reach more than one million people in the community through our impact initiatives.

I know you share the compliment and the call to action to make our community one of the healthiest in the nation.

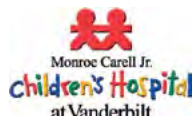

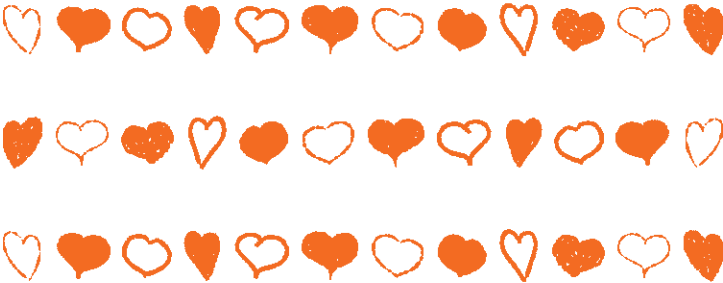
