

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How is the AHA helping in response to COVID-19?

In addition to funding lifesaving research and health initiatives in our community, our support of the American Heart Association is helping combat COVID-19 in many ways. Below are a few examples, and please visit https://www.heart.org/en/coronavirus to learn more.

- i. Committing \$2.5 million to <u>fast-track research grants</u> to better understand COVID-19 and its interaction with the body's cardiovascular and cerebrovascular systems.
- ii. Helping to <u>meet the needs of health care workers</u> by launching a new course on Oxygenation and Ventilation for COVID-19 patients in response to the shortage of masks and ventilators, offering training on how to safely administer CPR, and adding a COVID-19 data registry through Get with the Guidelines to better manage existing patients.
- iii. We are helping to accelerate antiviral drugs to combat COVID-19. Through the Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory, AHA technologies are being used in the COVID-19 response which may lead to better diagnoses and treatments.
- iv. Working with federal and state governments to ensure families have access to care, and that children who are at-risk of missing meals due to schools being closed are still looked after.
- v. Providing businesses with essential resources to help their employees stay healthy and active.

What does a "virtual event" entail?

In order to control the spread of the virus, the CDC is recommending postponing events with crowds of 50 or more. As a result, we have strategies in place to allow participants to fully experience the spirit of Lawyers Have Heart wherever they are. 2020 marks the 30th Anniversary of Lawyers Have Heart, so starting on May 14th we will be launching 30 days of content culminating in a city-wide effort to celebrate our impact on June 13th. Activities will include a virtual leaderboard, suggested routes to run your own 10K or 5K, training tips, and healthy living resources to look after yourself and your loved ones while social distancing.

Do I still need to register for the event?

YES! As a registered participant you will gain access to a full suite of our event resources. Those that pay the registration fee will receive a special edition 30th Anniversary Lawyers Have Heart t-shirt as well as a finisher medal and most importantly, you will be contributing to the American Heart Association's mission of being a relentless force for a world of longer, healthier lives.



What is the cost for registering to the virtual race?

There are two options when registering for the virtual race:

- Virtual Participant There is no cost for this option, and you will receive a finisher medal to commemorate the 30th Anniversary of Lawyers Have Heart
- Heart Hero You can become a Heart Hero for \$50 and you will receive a race t-shirt as well as the finisher medal commemorating the 30th Anniversary of Lawyers Have Heart!
